The Eastern seaboard along the Connecticut coastline is a truly diverse and mature fishery. Striped Bass are the main quarry species but Blue Fish, Bonito and False Albacore are all present and offer the fly fishing enthusiast fantastic fly-rod sport.

- Day 2-6 Guided Fly fishing for 5 days
